Structure right now to be able to detect which of these migrants is actually a criminal, a pervert, a rapist, you know, an escape convict, whatever. And on top of that,

some of them might not, even you know, have any documented evidence of such behavior. So what do we do? We have a party right now that is very similar to the Democrat party now, Real ID, as you all know, the deadline is May 7, 2025

that's in a few months. That's in less than a year.

Do you know what you can't do without real ID? First of all, unless you have a passport, right? So let's exclude the passport and stick to the REAL ID. Okay, we all know passport supersedes everything except for voting. Obviously, we've already engaged in that. Couple years ago, I had confrontation with

voting officials telling me that my passport does not prove that I'm a US citizen to vote and so on. But you have no idea what is about to hit us, and it's about time we start talking about Haiti

and Real ID.

So on May 7, 2025 that's a deadline to have it. The Real ID Act was passed in 2005 it was implemented to enhance national security by establishing stricter identification standards, and it requires individuals to show proof of not only legal presence, but other documentation, to obtain a Real

ID compliant driver's license or identification card. And this is mandated that you have not just to fly on airplanes, on domestic flights, but to be able to access federal facilities.

We're talking courts, federal buildings, and get this healthcare institutions. It is the most stringent identification that I have been talking about for a while. It's next generation identification that exists for domestic documentation. Now, anything that is federally regulated, any

federally regulated activity, you know, I don't know, maybe like campaigns, some some right events with presidents, Congress people, hospitals, court houses, you know, FBI offices, sheriff's offices, because they do get funds. Technically, if you don't have a Real ID, you will not be access. You will not gain access

to those facilities. This leads to grave implications in regards to mobility, right, transport, access to essential services and overall integration into society. You will not be able to enter any federally funded facility. That is a big deal, very big deal.

Without REAL ID. You won't be able to use your state issued identification to board domestic flights,

you need a passport,

and this restriction will require people that are non US citizens to have to provide their passport to travel. So if you are a citizen of Canada and you reside in the United States, you will be providing your Canadian passport to pop a flight to the next state for Thanksgiving. Now, TSA has put

the outline of what is approved

identification,

but now I want you to think of about 50 million undocumented individuals unable to do any of such things. Not only fly, but go to hospitals, federally funded facilities, federally funded activities and federal buildings, there are two things that can happen. One, they're granted just American

citizenship because they're here. Two, they create alternative IDs, which are costly, which will lack the security. Dirty that your REAL ID will have

in order to obtain it. Now,

do you know what that instantly does? Could you imagine how many food facilities, like, I don't know, like Whole Foods, they've already started with the facial recognition, palm payments. How many banks are going to start using real ID? Almost instantly, all of them will and so now what we have to remember is that we

will have over 50 million human beings unable to even do basic things. And I know a lot of you may say, Well, these people are here, so it's their fault, and therefore tough noogies they can leave.

As I've said, a lot of these people never wanted to come here. They were brought here, so it's important

access to certain federal facilities that will be limited are, of course, military bases, nuclear power plants, federal courthouses, any DHS building, any FBI building, anything that's funded with the majority of federal dollars, which pretty much includes most government structures, oh, including

schools. So now suddenly we're in a dystopic future where we are going to the supermarket, we are getting flights, our kids go to school, and we have 50 million people unable to do anything. Where are they going to live? In the sewers? Are they going to be like the steampunk era? Is that where we're going

to have so I want you to just think about that for a second. Think about what that says. Just Just think about it, state and local services. How? Have never stated that they will require real ID compliance that it only impacts federal facilities and air travels, but a lot of states have started already

implementing stricter identification requirements in alignment with federal standards. So and it's done for identification purposes, right? In a non federal context, you know, such as proving age or alcohol purchases or accessing non federal buildings. Non real ID compliant identification may

be accessible, and that is something that they've put together for our younger children, but that's only if you know they don't want to be on the system yet. Basically, undocumented immigrants can't get REAL ID. You have to applicants, have to have a US birth certificate, a US passport

or a foreign passport with a valid visa, of approved immigration documents. Now here's the kicker this, you know, I couldn't believe that I missed it while we're all talking about elections, while we're all talking about them needing voters, right? We have missed the mark. The one thing

President Trump and every single Republican should be saying right now is you guys are already in our border. If you're not a rapist and a criminal, is going to be very difficult for us to ship you the fuck back. So here's the deal, you won't be deported if you don't vote. Because voting when you're not a

US citizen is an auto deportation. It is against federal law. So if they were for the next 50 somewhat days, constantly saying, Hey, you're an illegal migrant. We're not gonna we're not gonna be able to deport you. We're only deporting criminals, okay? But if you vote, you will be automatically

deported. I don't give a shit if you pay taxes. I don't care if you have 50 kids. I don't care if you have integrated in society. Your whole city can stand up and say, you know, Josie is a great gal. She did all this shit, she did all this great stuff, but she voted so she's getting the fuck out.

Where am I going? Give zero fucks? Here's your one way ticket. This is how we mitigate we turn the fucking tables on them because we're stuck. Real ID is coming. Instead of us showing hate for all these migrants to win, we must show that we understand the situation. And the situation is

we don't need people, you know, dying of poverty, and the majority of which we're. Literally just brought here as fillers. Literally those stories you see about the caravans are bullshit. Okay, you cannot deport 50 million people. People are just stupid to just even say that your country has been

importing migrants on your freaking federal tax dollars through programs. Now, they ushered a shit ton of them through your southern border. And you think that you can deport them, you're not going to be able to, because, you know what? That's going to be ugly. It's going to be disgusting. The

minute someone has a slight accent, you're going to be like, deport them. And some people are that crazy that they'll probably shoot places up. You guys have no idea what's in store. We have to start having real conversations. Where is the infrastructure in order to understand who these

undocumented immigrants are that are within our nation right now, because DHS and border patrol haven't done fuck all down at the borders, and let's not talk about the northern border. So we have a serious problem, very serious problem. There's millions of people within our border who have gotten like a

paper to present themselves in court two years later, and that's if they come okay. And in a few months, we are going to be switching over to Real ID, which immediately puts them in, like basement, gutter, sewer dwelling areas. And we are going to have a problem. We cannot deport them all. And here's the thing, we

want to deport criminals. How the fuck do we know who's the criminal you think you're gonna really find out where you know Joe Schmo is from? One guy that looks after gonna be like, Yeah, I'm from Angola, but he's not. He's from Iberia, and he's like, a massive serial killer. You will never know, because other

countries don't maintain records, like Western nations. This is a very big problem. So rather than us thinking this, you know, the people that should what the Republicans should be doing, and those that want to be reelected should be doing is creating an infrastructure of how they could get it done. Our

president has said, it quick, we will deport all the criminals and we need to. But the problem is we have a bunch of people. I mean, look at the way they behaved with the Haitians. Look how disgusting people are. They're making memes and, I mean, it's funny. You guys know, I like my dink memes, okay, like

the honounds Yesterday. I still can't get over that meme. I still can't, but the Truth be said. We need to flip the tables. We need to start talking and saying, You guys are fucking here. We need to start pushing this narrative, because everybody wants this war, and you're going to get it, because if they steal the elections on

million undocumented human beings within our border? Yeah, Trump gets deport them all. No, the fuck you're not. What are you doing? Because you're not. What are you doing? Because you know people, when they say, Oh, we're deported, was like, you know, I even looked at him and I was like, you and I both know,

because you supposedly served, right? So you obviously know that we have to have agreements with countries. We can't just go to a country and say, here's a plane full of people. You can't do that. North Dakota, but the Orr said they only had 13. I lost my shit. I'm like, where are the rest of the hundreds of kids that just came with that batch of kids? And I started the investigations myself, and I prompted the HHS, you know, IG report, you guys should go read it. The HHS. IG did a thorough

audit of the state of North Dakota in 2015 that I did. Ask me about it. Why don't you guys ask Josh Galion that decided to actually audit them and Lutheran Social Services, these freaking NGOs, and what he found with the Miss king. And do you know what happened to him? Your amazing Republicans in the state

legislature passed a law saying the auditor can't audit unless they say it's okay to audit that agency or department. What does that tell you? And here we are talking nonsense. And you know? Okay, it's kind of funny showing President Trump saving ducks and kittens, but it's also divisive. See this love bombing they're

offering to the President and all these, look at us, Mr. Trump, isn't this funny. Hall are actually to harm him, because this is how they get the rhetoric of, you know, he's divisive and whatever. I mean, as you saw, most of your American youth, and youth, I mean, between 18 and 48 are

fucking dumb. Okay? They don't know where shit is on the map. Okay? They don't know anything. And they just listen to whatever's out there. They think Tiktok is a new source. Okay? So at this point, the only thing we can do is turn the tables and say, Listen, you're a migrant here. You know, you came here

legally into this country, which is a big problem. But how am I going to deport all 50 million of you? I'm going to deport every single criminal. I will go through your life with a fine tooth comb. But I will tell you this. I don't care how good you are, how compliant you are, how you pay your taxes, how you got

a job, how you volunteer in your community, you could have 10 freaking anchor babies. I will deport your ass the minute I see you voted once, because that's that's it, that's you pissing all over my nation's laws and saying, just because you walk through the border, you can vote. That's how we need to do

it. That is exactly how we do it. Hey, the laws of this nation say you have to be a US citizen to vote. Now, not only did you come through the border illegally, willingly or not, whatever? Or it may be, but if you vote, it means you do not respect the country you are in and you are out. I don't care

what you have to say. And if we start pushing that message, they all know President Trump is going to win. They all know Kamala is not going to win. They all know we're armed to the teeth, they already know. So the best way to flip the tables is to tell them, because you know, without saying they know,

here it is.

You vote you're getting deported, even if you're not a criminal. I don't give a shit. 20 anchor babies. You're still deported. You don't have family there. They've all been killed, still deported, but you're a refugee because your whole family was hung for whistleblowing. Don't give a

shit. Don't vote. Oh, do you have a green card? Did you vote with your green card? Because see, that's another thing people don't think about. Do you know how many people with green cards have voted? And you're gonna be like, Well, how would we know that it's on the record? I mean, they scan your ballot, and then

we have to go into the how many people didn't vote, but were voted for that were illegal in the first place, and green card holders, ha, didn't think of that, did you? Because it could be Mr. APU, who's your surgeon, that's from India, on a green card, working here. He doesn't vote because he's Indian. He's

on a work visa as a doctor. But you know, on the voter records, Mr. APU voted. Did Mr. APU vote or didn't he? Well, that'll be easy to figure out. You got a phone, right, buddy. Oh, and this is where we may have innocent people thrown out too. That's the way it's gotta be done.

That's the way it's gotta be done.

here, mom voted when she shouldn't, or dad voted when he shouldn't, get the fuck out. Here's a one way ticket Bye, and we have to have them go themselves, or we could tell them, here's what's going to happen. You won't have your kids. Your kids will be put up for adoption or in foster care.

Would you like that? And all of you are going to be in prison making license plates for free because you broke the law. We can do that too. We have to be stronger on our loss. We have to make sure that people are talking about this, because no one is. These are 50 million people, 50 million people, 50

million people, 50 So aside from the fact that we need no machines in the elections, which they're not backing down on. I mean, how else are they going to steal it? Right? Even though it's going to help us with critical infrastructure like power, like water, you know, or protecting us from nukes and you

know it that's coming down from the north, we should be protecting who votes. And the message should be clear, if you are not a US citizen and you hold a green card, or you're undocumented and you've invaded this country and you vote, you will be automatically deported, along with your fucking family,

period. And that's what we should start putting down. This is the groundwork we should be putting forward. Because when it, when I hear, when, when he said that, I said, you know, actually, I said, um, yeah, I do. I look like a donor to you, what like? And that took him back a bit. I was like, I'm not

a donor, and you and I both know that's not happening, so why are you saying it? You're it's insulting to your voter to say shit like that. You should say the accurate thing. When Trump is in office, we're deporting all the criminals. Okay? And that's exactly what we're gonna do. Every single criminal will be deported.

Every single one

the biggest criminals, aside from the murders, the rapists, the drug dealers, human traffickers, etc, etc, the biggest crime anyone who has crossed that border willfully or unwillfully. Okay, and those with green cards, if you vote, you should be automatically deported. So I would tell the

Democrat base and all these migrants, both with green cards, not hey, if you are a foreigner and not a US citizen, legally here, legal here, whatever the case may be, don't vote. And not only that, because the Democrats are so desperate. Listen to this. This is key. The Democrats are so desperate that they will

even use your name and vote for you. Every single migrant that I have come across that's legally in this country, the Uber driver, The 711 guy, oh, which, by the way, I didn't tell you that the 711 thing was actually a deal struck by India too, you know, to bring in, to give businesses more favorable to Indian migrants if

they came on a specific program that the corporation had with the country of India. It Like It's guys. You have no idea how long they've been importing people. Okay, this has been an ongoing thing, but now they got bold. They thought, if we can bring in enough to stymie proper operations of the state, where

they will declare a federal emergency, and therefore we have access to it. We've got control of this situation. That's number one, right? They're sucking off the teeth of your state funds, right? Suddenly you have a federal emergency, then we get funds. And where do those funds go? To the NGOs? And what are

And not only that, you may not

So you have to find a way to secure that they don't vote for you because you're still getting deported, because we can't prove if you did it or they did it. So this is where you need to come out. I mean, they have a lot of irons in the fire right now, but I digress on that, don't I? But

here is a video of one man talking about the issues in his area, and how he spoke about it, but and he actually had some compassion, and that's what I'm seeing so much lack of compassion.

Yes, it's terrible. They're overrun. Yes, it's terrible. You're not used to seeing cats on the menu, or someone you know at the park, you know, taking out a goose so he could take it home and eat it. I get it.

It's like, kind of odd that, like a guy like me has to come out from doing what I do on a daily basis to have fun, because I see what's going on in these streets, and I see you guys. Is just sitting up there in them comfy chairs and suits and like. And I'm getting out here every day and I'm broadcasting this,

and you guys are just sitting up there in suits or something like, I really challenge you guys to get out here and do something. These Haitians are running into trash cans. They're running into buildings. They're running into. They flipping cars in the middle of the street. And I don't know how, like, Y'all

can be comfortable with this, like, I don't know, like, who's getting paid from this. I feel like, I honestly feel like someone's getting paid from it. In the background, they dropping that. You got a bunch of people on a bus getting dropped off at a gas station to come down here. I know a single mom that

FaceTimed me tonight, FaceTime me this morning at the welfare office that really need like, that really need something, and it's nothing but immigrants over there, and I don't even want to like, seem like I'm coming down on the immigrants, because it's the people that's bringing them down here. Because wherever

they're at that's what they're used to, bro. They're in the park grabbing up ducks by their neck and cutting their head off and walking off with them and eating them. Like, Y'all get the highway State Patrol down here every week, and then y'all get like, a task force for the highway State Patrol, and they

look for guns, and they look for dope and this and that in the fourth that same people that y'all got riding up and down limestone, doing U turns, pulling people over for blinkers, and pulling people over for, like, going left to center in like, a couple miles over, like, Y'all can take them

same people the highway State Patrol, and you can take them in every single one of their silver charges and dodge the ringos. And y'all can take them to sunset, and y'all can park them right over there, and y'all can teach people how to drive. Since the highway State Patrol know so much how to buy, know so much

about traffic laws, and know what to do in traffic, they need to, y'all pay them. They can go over and teach these Haitians how to drive, because it's getting a bro, I'm getting 1000s of views on on these and it's going to get bigger, and it's only going to get worse. And y'all sitting up there in these

chairs, y'all all, y'all need to get out here and do something. Y'all making hundreds of \$1,000 y'all need to put on a t shirt and some crocs, and then y'all need to come out here in these streets, and y'all need to go out here. And, uh, I'm out here before the police is like, Y'all need to do something. Bro, y'all

really gotta stand on Minutes. Y'all getting paid all this money just to wear a suit and sit in a chair. I don't think, I think it's, I think it's crazy. Bro, they like, We gotta do something. Bro, it's kids out here getting hurt. Like, only reason I even went on here and said something about it is

because somebody told me they walking from the school, and the Haitian almost ran into them. And who is getting paid? Like, how much money is y'all really getting paid? Like, to bring them over here? Like, I know it's deeper than them. I know that's where they come from, and that's what they do. That's they

country. I don't know what they got going on over there, but they can't do that over here. And if y'all just getting paid from it, and then y'all ain't doing that about I think that's super weird, bro, y'all gotta stand on business. Y'all gotta really, like, step up. Like, it's lame, bro. Like, for real.

Thank you for your comments. Thank you

for your comments. Stay safe from their thrones. Thanks for the comments. We'll take that into consideration. You. We got our side piece. Now I just want you to think about it. How is it that we can change the conversation to let them know they all know that President Trump is winning, and I'm going

to tell you conversations I had with real people, just to showcase that. And this is from homeless people, undocumented invaders, and that woman actually told me how she got there, right? These are real stories, the stuff that your sensationalist media that get paid insane amounts of money and

give you bullshit, reactive narratives, right? Should be doing real stories, not shit that gets you pissed off, right? We need logical solutions and have faith more in humanity, damn it, like people have been so disconnected, some of the comments that I see make me irk

completely,

because I understand how angry you are. I'm more angrier. I am a lot more angrier because I tried to stop this a long time ago and it didn't work. Have a little faith. Let's take a quick break from

turmoil, from endless pain. You from endless pain, but united, we stand to fight and we fall in unity.

We shatter the shame God, we

just let this be our dream to build bridges on walls, to

boil in the embrace. Unity, we find the strength to coexist. You see you see

ardent angels watch from above, guiding us with the wings. Of love they whisper.

Now welcome back. I know a lot of you are pissed off, but let me tell you something right now in a small Ohio city, the rhythm of actual life had been semi steady. Their average income, not so much, not such a big population. It's shaped, though, by generations of hardworking families who built their

livelihoods over decades. But now everything has shifted in the past couple years, a massive group of migrants, almost 20% of their existing population has now been increased by another 20% right of these Haitians that were displaced or uprooted from their homeland, willingly or unwillingly and found themselves

in an unfamiliar place that many of them never asked to be In, strangers in the land of Rust Belt grit and farmlands they're accustomed to, like surviving with little, eating garbage, cats and whatever wildlife they can catch, and pigeons, pigeons, guys. I remember as a kid, my grandmother had grabbed a

pigeon, the nastiest bird ever. And I remember watching her drown it in a bucket and drowning them because she's like, we're gonna have pigeon for for dinner. And I'm like, ew, I'm not eating a pigeon. And she was like, why not? But it was normal for her, you know, or where I would drive down the

road, and, you know, my my family members, we like, stop, stop. You know, there's dandelions. And I was like, and they're like, no, no, we can make something. You know, we can make boiled dandelions. They're delicious, which I love, by the way, right? But we would stop on the side of the highway and just

pick them up in other countries, and it would be no big deal. People forget that, because you're so accustomed to supermarkets, right? But these people have different ways of lives, so for these new arrivals, right, their struggle was raw and immediate. You have to think of it this way, okay,

we're not inhumane, right? We understand. We've been fucked, okay? Our nation has been ravished. Okay? We don't need to say more on that. We already know it. But those people really had nothing but their instincts and resilience. The ducks in the lake in the park, the stray cats wandering the streets, or even

dogs and pigeons are now their food. It's a desperate solution to even a more desperate situation. So if it wasn't out of malice or intent to disturb, but sheer necessity. And yet, people are starting to fracture in the city. And what started is quiet whispers soon became accusations like the stolen cat

was a fake freaking post just to agitate people. Agitate people paid for and paid for. So you have to see who started reporting it first, because that's how you can find it. Kind of like I told you with the covid deaths, the first report coming out of China was from Voice of America. The fuck out

of here. Okay, it was our own government. But anyway, I digress. So these acts of survival by a few of them, not all of them. Some, you know, acclimated faster. Some are like, I don't know. Other people don't do that shit. I don't think it's okay. Some may have asked, Hey, there's like, ducks

in the lake. Can I go get it? And they're like, Nah, man, we don't do that shit here. Other people probably didn't ask, okay? So people fear what they don't understand, right? And the divide between the long standing residents and the new arrivals there has now deepened with high tensions and hostility. You

know, blame is being cast not on the system that failed, you know, their own residents, but the system that imported these people without asking the residents on their dime, thrust into a community that was obviously unprepared for their arrival, that they never asked for, right? And you know, while

everyone's like, well, they could get food they have food stamps. Food Stamps are your state fucking tax dollars, okay, state and federal tax dollars. You're paying for it. It's illegal. What your city officials did is illegal. Your frustration is misplaced. Yes, you can be pissed when you've

got an MS 13 gang running around in Texas with a machete chopping up people. Fuck yeah, you can, and rightfully so. But you know who's to blame the people that brought them in the NGOs. Okay? Now what the residents of all cities and little villages that are affected by this should be gathering their little small

groups in their city halls, around kitchen tables, voicing their frustrations and and the system that failed. Both them and those people, is about time you start seeking accountability to them, just like the guy said, you're sitting up there in your chairs with the put on your Crocs and your T shirts, come

down here and see what they're doing. And you know, we that's the thing. You know. A lot of people say you can ship them back. A lot of people are saying this, but what if they don't want to? fucking deal. They're like, fuck it. This country's a shit show. Bye. I can start over with \$10,000 in my country, right? The others will be like, Look, my country had nothing to offer. I've been honest, I've been working. I would really love to assimilate and be part of your country. Good, and that's the

thing that we should be pushing. Hey, we're watching you. You vote, you're automatically deported. I don't care how good you are. You vote on your green card, you're automatically deported if denied. I don't give a shit if you're the top surgeon in the world, people have to fly to wherever the fuck you are,

because you're not going to be here in this country. So this is it. There is no infrastructure for managing citizenry. And here's the here's the double edged sword. None of us want this Real ID, because you will not be able to buy, sell and survive without it. But how are we going to stop it when it's

the segue of them fucking us in the first place by flipping the table? If you flip the table on them and terrify them and suggest, and not just suggest, but actually be, be bonafide fair and say, All right, you know Maria Vasquez, from wherever you came from, you came here. You didn't ask for it,

right? You obviously have no family at home. You're here. You worked, you registered, you got your little law document. You didn't break the law. You were never a criminal, and you didn't vote. That means you want to be a citizen. Here is a temporary green card, and let's see how you do, and in 10 years, we'll

talk, just like all green card holders do. In 10 years, we'll talk, and you can stay here legally now, right? That is how we have to do it. We have to be humane. You have to be humane. Because when I see all this rhetoric of this nasty, nasty, it's just because they're stupid, like I saw two

journalists, both female bimbos, coming out to talk about it. What the fuck are you gonna talk about? Say how nasty it is, how they're eating cats and dogs and ducks? Well, in their country, it's normal, okay? In their country, it's normal, and this is how you can mitigate what's coming if we don't start talking

about them correctly, and real ID comes, we're all fucked. Countries versus the cities won't be in a fun, fun way. And don't forget, President Trump did talk about those freedom cities. So then you have to think to yourself, who's going to be in the freedom cities that are going to be high tech,

highly monitored and highly compliant with very stringent laws. Because when you think freedom, what do you think you're going to be doing, farming? Get it right now. The what, what, what we have to think of. It's not a question of charity right now, right

because we need to know who made decisions without consulting the people of these cities and states bring them in the programs that had funneled public money into the relocation effort and have left their own people abandoned, again, not A question of charity, it's a question of sovereignty. Every

city has its own identity. The city had like Springfield has survived hard times before, but it wasn't fair to ask the residents to bear the burden of bureaucratic mismanagement. All why local services are crumbling and resources for their own families are disappearing. Remember when I found out that

Cuyahoga County became a welcoming America city or county, I would say I wanted to find out, and I'm still demanding to find out, and they haven't responded as that with what authority did they spend money to be qualified to a foreign global NGO, no one answered the question, how much

Is a private helicopter pilot, a trained EMT, a qualified ROV, which I had to look up what that was, and a deep worker, submarine pilot. In addition to being fluent in four languages, this is what I had written down

before I realized that she spoke at the UN nine times since the last time I saw her so Prince

Andrew's link to the late accused sex trafficker Jeffrey Epstein. Now a photograph of Epstein's alleged accomplice is raising even more questions, and you can see Ghislaine Maxwell here sitting on a throne next to actor Kevin Spacey. The photo was reportedly taken on a tour of Buckingham Palace back in

2002 Maxwell is facing charges for her alleged role in grooming underage girls on Epstein's behalf,

The shocking development and investigation by the Wall Street Journal has revealed that Instagram is promoting networks of pedophiles who actively participate in sharing Child Sexual Abuse content, and that the algorithms even help pedophiles connect to each other. And the researchers found

out that accounts that are actively participating in such sort of content, well, they are advertised using explicit hashtags and when they do actually connect services, and a whole range of menu is offered to them, wherein they can buy, sell and even commission such content. Wall Street Journal

further revealed when the researchers actually tried following some of these accounts, Instagram actually recommended more of these accounts to the researchers, which suggests that Instagram algorithms unknowingly might be promoting such content. And now that the report has come out,

meta has come forward and issued a statement which says that child exploitation is a horrific crime, the company said, and that meta is actively investigating ways to defend against this behavior. Metapos claim that in January alone this year, the company was able to remove four lakh, 90,000 of

accounts that were violating its child safety policies, and that it also removed 27 pedophile networks from the app. It also further claimed that it has also removed hashtags that further promote this behavior. A Stanford internet observatory researcher named David Thiel has revealed to the Wall Street

Journal that Instagram is not right at promoting a right balance between its recommendation systems, he said, and I quote, you have to put guardrails in place for something that is growth intensive to still be nominally safe, and Instagram hasn't the billionaire founder of Tesla as

well as SpaceX, Elon Musk,

hold on before I continue, I wanted to say something so back in 2020 when The lockdowns happen, I had stumbled upon profiles on Twitter that had child pornography. I actually wrote an article about it at that time, Twitter source code wasn't that easy, where you can actually locate IMEI of you

know, I may IMEI of a device or location. It was a little bit difficult to do, but what I did find was that Facebook actually had protected accounts. Here's what I mean. So some of those accounts that were hosting the child pornography had like a shield so you couldn't snapshot their profiles. So you know the

comment that was made by one of my listeners just now, which was they were protecting those that had the child porn is accurate because I saw it, because the profiles of the people that were linked, you know, in regards to activity between Twitter and 2020, and Facebook, I couldn't screenshot it. How do you. Use

another phone to take a picture of the Facebook profile. So I had written an article about child pornography on Twitter, but banning conservatives and they were actually protected, like you couldn't screenshot their profile, even their you know, front facing profile photo, there was like a little

shield, but now you can only do that. When you try to snapshot, it won't let you it'll come out black. It's like the same technology they use for Netflix, for people trying to take image pictures of stuff. So I just wanted to throw that in there.

I cited the matter as extremely concerning. So

we have other tools for engagement on the site, which is how i i try to grow the site. So, because you do own the ocean, I want to work with Google on this case,

if you said to you and others, that is, we know is not true, what are the lies that you say? You know point blank.

Well, let's not even go into the stuff they talked about in the interview. Let's talk about this little piece of paper. It's about four inches by three. This is the so called brochure that the Americans were giving out to people who were handing over children. First line, we want to help Haitian children who have

lost their mother and father. That is not true. Most of these children were not orphans, and in many cases, it was their own mother and or father that handed over the kids to the Americans, and the Americans knew that, because their translators were translating that for them, lie to new children. Refuges, a

nonprofit dedicated to loving and caring for orphan, abandoned Haitian children the Dominican Republic. We understand that that the the organization isn't even yet registered as a nonprofit, and it certainly isn't dedicated to looking after any kind of kids in the DR because that school and

orphanage is not set up yet. It is still a 45 room motel that hasn't been converted.

And before we continue, I want to put a little parentheses here. Let's remember that it was then when Governor Mike DeWine in Haiti opened up a school next an orphanage and a church. Number one, number two. Let's also remember that at the Dominican Republic, one of the most frequent stops that Epstein

made from PBI, there is a resort flanking the hotel where these children were going. Do you know who owns that resort? Huh? Fawn jewel brothers. They're in Florida. They're very big donors to both the Republican one brother goes and pays the Republicans and and the other brother pays the Democrats. But

nobody wants to talk about the kings of sugar. They own sugar, which is in everything, your bread, your food, your everything. They own, all the sugar. So these people facility, and they're walking around in high socialite life in Florida right now. What's happening with them? Has anyone looked at their

donations? Is anyone looking at the Dominican Republic and their resort that flanks the airport that Epstein would frequent, and where Silsby, who changed her name and then became head of missing children, right? Is there nobody talks about the fond jewels. Why? Well, maybe the Department of Justice,

looking at all these funding of narratives of your alt media, will maybe bring up a little bit of sugar, huh? Think about it for a second. Think about it for a second. Let's continue. This is unedited, five and a half hours footage that I've been working on. Well, Miguel was so nice to put it all together for

me in one file about NGOs. Here we go.

Third lie on this single piece of paper, we have permission to bring orphan kids into our orphanage in the Dominican Republic. Not true. The Dominican console told the Americans at 2pm on Friday, you do not have the paperwork. It is illegal what you're doing, do not travel. Four hours later at

the border, the Americans were arrested, and then final lie they're talking about, you can follow the progress of your kids on our website. The website is not up and running yet. Anderson, it's and so

they're handing this out. I mean, essentially, what we now know is they were around in Port au Prince, trolling for kids. I mean, going around trying to collect kids under the age of 10. So for whatever reason, they could take them to Dominican Republic. And what they we had also just learned today is they

had told that guy, David Lewis, they were actually going to bring some of these kids into the United States or United States, or they'd offer to bring Richard's kids into the back to the United States, which, you know the fact that Richard and his wife, that his wife said, Look, do not go to this

orphanage where our kids are in the process of being legally adopted. And they went anyway to try to get them to me, that just raises. All sorts of red flags.

Certainly does red red flags, as well as the fact that they were looking for children aged from zero to 10. Kids are aged under under 10. I asked an NGO specialist about that. Why zero to 10? He says, kids of zero to 10 are much easier to send in adoption. You can bet your bottom dollar. If those kids were

going to be sent into adoption, they weren't going to be adopted in the DR, they would have been sent abroad for that. Maybe the DR was a halfway house. I don't know that for sure, though, but certainly you know the people that you've talked to tonight, you can piece it together. It seems like that. And yes,

certainly there were trolling for orphanages as well, because the three translators that we've spoken to extensively have said that they also were asked to telephone another orphanage and that other orphanage also declined.

A major earthquake shook the Caribbean nation of Haiti late today it hit just 14 miles from the capital city, Port au Prince. The US geological survey reported a magnitude of 7.0 the largest ever recorded in that region. Reports said the presidential palace and a hospital collapsed, along with

Americans have been detained by Haitian police as they tried to bus more than 30 children across the border into the Dominican Republic, allegedly without proper documents, we

had 33 children from the age of two months to 12 years, and in the in the course of the time frame, we had them with us, obviously the entire team deeply fell in love with these children. They're very, very precious kids that have lost their homes and their families and are so, so deeply in need of

most of all, God's love and His compassion and just a very nurturing setting. The

Americans are Baptist church members from Idaho, and they were planning to take the children to the Dominican Republic, where they plan to establish an orphanage. The group's leader, Laura Silsby, says the group paid no money for the children and obtained them from a well known pastor who

heads a religious ministry in Haiti. Our

understanding was, is that we were told by a number of people, including Dominican authorities, that that we would be able to bring the children across. I understand that, sir, that's the mistake, obviously we made, is we did not understand that there was additional paperwork required.

You mean, additional paperwork? It's so interesting. Very interesting. You know, I've written articles about Haiti before, and you should go look at them and how Sean Penn, which was one camp and Hillary Clinton the other camp were fighting for territory. And you have to think of your think of it for a

second, Sean Penn, the guy that got, you know, the meeting with the biggest King ping of Mexico, when the CIA and FBI couldn't find him. You remember that Sean Penn, the Sean Penn that appears at every war. You know that Sean Penn, Sean Penn and Hillary Clinton were fighting? How do I know this? Because it was in

Hunter Biden's emails, and I wrote about it. And also remember the leader of Haiti that was assassinated, and those people went in, they were all people that work with Sean Penn wrote an article about that too, and it's so weird that no one's paying attention. No one is paying attention. You know, it

hurts me that there's so much hate to these Haitians. But right now, do you know what Haiti looks like? It is so unstable, and it is occupied by Kenyan military, and no one is talking about that. All these people that make fucking half a million a week are not talking about it. Instead, they're

sharing cat memes and duck fucking memes, wearing stupid fucking beanies, working with assets. And didn't I say in September, a lot of podcasters are going down. I mean, it started with the whole Julie Kelly thing. It was like, Oh, he's a fed. She's doing great work. She's doing great work. So

stop hate. But stop hate was the organization that pushed through the fucking barriers with their people, but here we are saying they're great, forgetting that it was Olly Akbar who led this whole shit going forward, let me just continue this for a sec.

From the moment of their arrest, they had defended their innocence, saying they were just trying to help the children, and after three long weeks in jail, a Haitian judge believed them, granting freedom to eight of the 10 Americans charged with child trafficking. But

the job recognize that there's any evidence about their guilty, they are all innocent. That what I can tell you, and the world has to know after these, these issue, that there's. American all of them are innocent, as I promised you, that they will be free. Eight of the of them are now free.

The judge did, however, order that the group's leader, Laura Silsby, another woman, remain in custody. They were in Haiti before the earthquake, and their activities are the subject of further investigation. The group of Americans, most of

they were in Haiti before the earthquake. What have I said about earthquakes? See today, and I'll play this later. You know, Colorado is really, really excited that they're going to weather modify to get rain and seed the clouds with chemicals to make it rain. Yet, the same people that are talking about

It was also learned one of the lawyers defending the group was a man suspected of sex trafficking. Haiti's President Rene Preval defended the judge's decision and dismissed concerns the court

had been persuaded by US officials to set the Americans free.

System is totally is back on American soil. She was freed by Haitian authorities after she was convicted of illegally trying to take dozens of Haitian children out of the country in the wake of January's giant earthquake. He cried and she greeted family members at the airport. That

was incredible. I

just give praise to Michael. Thank you for bringing me home.

Thank you for

bringing me home. Salisbury said her faith had gotten her through the ordeal, but she declined to answer reporters questions about what the last three months have been like.

You know, I'll talk about that maybe at a later time. Today is a day of celebration, enjoy my family and my friends and I have longed for this for a long time.

In addition to her family, members of her church also showed up to greater their

faithful prayers have meant a tremendous amount to me, and we just serve an awesome God, and I just give all the praise and glory to Him.

Kenyans don't even know why they're there, and they're actually raising money to feed themselves because they can't. Let me introduce you to this man.

all right, all right, all right, all right. Todd Robinson, we've got his financials. Think I mentioned him at one point. Pay attention to who this guy is, who is in many, many, many places.

Todd's a career diplomat with a wealth of experience, who has previously served as investment to Guatemala and. Trade affair in Venezuela, and he's also a good friend, Ambassador Todd Robinson. Welcome to Democracy dialogs. Thank you so much for having me. You know, organized crime seems to be one of the

most pervasive issues growing around the region. It's a real problem. We see what's happening right now in Ecuador and other places. What's your assessment of organized crime in the region from an overall perspective? Well, you know, it's a great question. Look, we have transnational organized

criminals working throughout the hemisphere, undermining institutions, terrorizing communities, ordinary citizens from the United States all the way down into Argentina and Chile, sapping resources and you raised a great point. Ecuador is one of those countries that has really suffered recently. They

had a presidential candidate assassinated, a major Prison Break, public enemy number one on the streets. Now what we have been trying to do, what the United States government has been trying to do. And what the Bureau of International Narcotics and Law Enforcement has been trying to do is to

focus on the long term solutions, rebuilding institutions, working with police and prosecutors, working with judges, you know, giving them the training they need to see what they need to be looking out for. Some of the best work we do around the hemisphere and around the world is on

corrections, you know, focusing on those men and women who put their lives on the line for the for the country to to protect ordinary citizens, making sure they have the training, the equipment, the resources necessary to do their jobs. And that's what we're going to do in Edward as you know, general

Richardson. I will be going down all of that to really assess the situation and ensure new president Novoa that he has the the confidence and the cooperation and the support of the United States to do the right thing for his country. The Western Hemisphere is a really large place, and each country is

different in its own way. Have you seen certain strategies that can be replicated nonetheless in certain countries? In other words, what's worked particularly well, not just working with police or judges or law enforcement, presumably, but what are some of the strategies that you find that are

replicable? Well, when you talk about in South America or in the hemisphere, one of the countries we look at is Colombian. They really are the gold standard. And it took, you know, a decision by ordinary Colombians to make a change supported by the international community, focusing on potato issues,

safety, security, again, reinforcing those institutions and showing them that if they just do their job, you can really make a change. We now use Colombia around the hemisphere and around the world, because they have that expertise now, and because they've been through it all, that has really worked.

You combine the security with development assistance, and you don't, doesn't have to just be the United States, right? You can, you can use other countries. We can. We work very well with the Norwegians on the Colombian peace process. Now, you know, France, Spain, the UK, the Netherlands, they all have a

part to play as an important part to play in city and security and development around the world. Those are the kinds of things that work. You know, it's not there's no silver bullet. And you know, there's not any one thing you really need a good cooperation within the interagency a good

cooperative, good cooperation among the international community. And focus on institutions. You know, what do we want the police, the judiciary, the prisons, political parties? What do we want them to look like, 510, 15 years down the road? And how do we want them to be able to

defend themselves from those dangers to democracy? That's what that's what I know does. That's what we try to do, and that's what we try to do, working with our partners in the interagency and the international community, another prison resonates. I just had the privilege to host our new US,

Ambassador to Guatemala, who had experience in Mexico, of course, and one of his key points was, prison reform is so critical, and it resonates. It's like concentric circles that goes out from prisons into society, and really helps undermine democracy if you don't get those prisons under control. That's right.

That's absolutely right. And one of the things, one of the real success stories that we saw in Guatemala when I was there as an ambassador, was the corrections reform. We were fortunate. We have now, one of the best experts on correctional reform that I know of, and she was able to institute a program. Am

really turning corrections around in Guatemala, and we have indications that the incoming revenue government wants to continue that work. So we're really happy about that. Let's talk about Guatemala and Central America more broadly, first of all, congratulations to the States or to the US government,

but more importantly, to the Guatemalan people for getting through a successful election and inauguration of the new president, Bernardo. Are the guests here, actually at democracy dialogs, and really proud to have that opportunity. Absolutely,

we're here with Ambassador. So I just want to tell you something about Todd Robinson. All right, Mr. Robinson. Mr. Robinson is implicated in allegations of human and especially child trafficking. He gets large sums of money in his foreign accounts that I may or may not have access to. Some of them are

actually professors at universities in California, purchasing things from him for 60 grand or whatever, and they meet each other somewhere in the southern portion of our nation. This guy has been in Central and South America so long he owns their assets. In fact, let me show you something. As you know,

there's a lot going on in regards to Haiti and Central America right now. Let's see if I can pull this up. All right, let's see. Perfect. Here's a tweet,

recent tweet

from en me soras Unidas, so I put the translation for you to know right now, two representatives of the United States, State Department visited journalist Jose Ruben Zamora Marroquin on Friday, who has been in prison since July 2022 now, one must ask themselves, what's going on here? Why is the

State Department there? And the question is, why are State Department officials visiting someone who's in prison for blackmailing, extortion, cocaine, trafficking and money laundering. It's because he actually worked with Todd Robinson. Mr. Todd Robinson worked with this criminal that

is in prison that they're talking about, who they allege is a journalist. But there's one guy. Now, I haven't done much digging, per se, and I'm going to give you a name, Carlos gamara, and there's another two names too. Works at the State Department. State Department. He's currently in Central

America trying to pay off elected officials in various Central American nations to overthrow politicians that will not assist in covering up whatever they're covering up. That's all I have to say on that for now. So going back to Haiti and the Haitian migrants, we look so hateful, so hateful.

I know it's a cat, I know it's a duck, and you're like, Fuck, I don't need this shit. 20% of my city's population just increased with 20% of people that don't understand cultural norms here, my city and state have to fork up a shit ton of money so they can acclimate. I can't even take my kid to school sometimes

because they don't speak English anymore. I should bring an interpreter. These are all real things, but here's the deal, aside from everything that's going on internationally and it's all coming undone, I mean, the Kenyans being stranded while occupying Haiti is a big deal. And the one thing I've always

said is that Kenya is a front of the Soros Foundation. So why would the Soros Foundation suddenly starve up the money of the 1000s of troops that the Kenyans sent out there. Think about it for a second. You should think about this. Think why is it that so many Kenyans are there in Haiti right now

with no money?

And I was just there, right?

And, you know, it's like nobody wants to talk about it. Why has Kenya sent 1000s of soldiers? Why did they arrive to Haiti? What does Kenya have to do with Haiti? Oh, you know, the Kenyans are really good at moving people. And do you know that the majority of the African influx that come through these paid

programs for children are based out of Kenya? And also, did you know that Ilhan Omar came out of one of these NGOs as well, out of Kenya, even though she's from Somalia, i. Because it's the epicenter of trafficking. See, it's so weird. They're trying to regain control for what

is there

foreign military from a nation that has nothing to do with Haiti there, and nobody wants to talk about it. Everyone's pretending it's not happening. We need to show compassion. We need to show that we are humane. And I know a lot of you are very frustrated with this whole migrant situation. So am I? I'm

pissed, too. But the people that authorize this are the Office of Refugee Resettlement, the Orr, it is your state government in Ohio. Do you know who's responsible for this? Huh? Department of job and Family Services, also known as jobs. You know, the one that I've been talking about that when Frank

Larose, who is now the Secretary of State, used to just be in state legislature, right? Who comes from a wealthy home called House La Rose. He's not a Green Beret that came from a farm, right? His dad owns one of the biggest liquor distributors, right? So house Larose created, it is jobs, something liquor?

What is it? Beverage services. Remember, they're a weft partner. You can look jobs, Ohio is a partner with the weft. Okay? They're responsible, because they have federal partners to place migrants into local communities, and then you have state level refugee set of resettlement programs. So

instead of people right, focusing on them. I mean, you should for security, of course, you should be banging down the doors of your Mayor's office and be like, Bitch answer the question, Who the fuck paid you? Where'd the money come from. And hey, Larose, what the fuck is your daddy doing? What is jobs

Ohio fucking getting to bringing all these migrants, because state agencies coordinate with federal partners. Who are you partnering with? See when people, when people don't pay attention, don't ask the right question, they misdirect their frustration and you get lost, misdirection, kind of like I

said with the Tim pool and Benny Johnson, which everyone wants to hear about. I'm going to tell you that there have been two companies that I have privately messaged that fund a lot of your media stars and wannabes and bimbos, and I told them, hey, word on the street is your fucking company is going down,

whoa, we're not doing anything. And it's like, okay, but maybe your guy you're funding is doing something. I mean, I'm not saying you're not doing anything, but I'm saying if you say that, then maybe the people you're funding is a problem, hmm, because there's active investigations. So both of them

kind of went dead after I said, Hey, we should talk about this. But after what happened with tenant, I was like, Oh, I guess you're up next, or maybe the other one, but we'll see who comes in which order, because I was right again. Now, I don't say this to be like, Look, I'm right. I'm saying I did tell you

a lot of your social media superstars, you know, like that weird guy with the beanie that knows why he's got that traffic, but we do know it's paid advertising. You spend a lot of money for advertising, and that's how you get there, right? But he had Cassandra Fairbanks working as producer.

Let's not forget Cassandra Fairbanks was part of Code Pink and worked for Bernie Sanders. I mean, stop, like, stop, stop, stop, stop. You know it's, it's so weird when you see these things and you're just like, um, I kind of said it. Now, while all of you are like, holy shit, these motherfuckers make a lot

of money. Yes, they do, and I and I get offered a lot of money. I got a proposition from a foreign country to be transparent. It was No, I shouldn't anyway to prop their tourism. They even offered me a trip and a shit ton of money. There are people that throw the fuck out of money to me, and I'm

like, no thanks. If you want to contribute, you can go to my subscribe star, or sign up on my rumbles or locals, or, you know, Cash App me, or PayPal me. You know, that's about the extent you know what I'm saying. Like no, because then you have to tell me what to do. I have a ton of emails that I can, that I can

demonstrate where brands will say and this is how much I'm worth. For a 15 second spot, I will pay you three and a half \$1,000 and you only have to say it twice a week, six and a half \$1,000 just for that one ad. I don't do it, and it's something benign, something stupid, like a drink or freaking. Food or buy

my scarf, like a ton, I just don't do it because, no matter what, oh, yeah, or buy me a coffee. Thanks, Jules, um, she that's how, that's what I tell them. When the companies come and they're like, we'd love to sponsor you. I'm like, you could buy me a coffee. Sign up to my subscribe star. Send me locals.

I take some crypto, like, Thanks, though, but I don't want to do your ads. Thanks. I'd love it. I mean, right now, being courted for some, you know, big show all the time. They're like, we'll give you, you know, half a million a month. The contract this, no, because then I lose my voice. I'm told what I can say.

I'm not a bimbo with tits that wants to get paid to read shit, right? I don't do that. And here's the thing, Tim pool's a fucking bimbo that reads shit. He's a nobody. He means nothing, but a lot of advertising has gone into him, right? Because you have to think to yourself, why is he? Why? Where's his

point of view? If you saw a thinkologist pulled up, he's pushing the Civil War. And so while all of you're like, Damn these make money. You have no idea, the guys that make the stupid podcast even make more money, the ones that are funded by companies, okay, but don't misplace your anger because

jealousy, you know, because they make more money shit. I want to make 400,000 a week. I would love that, right? I would totally that means they're smart. I mean, shit, getting 1.2 million a week for being an idiot and gaslighting the people and talking shit like, you know what you're talking about. Fuck.

That's that's like the American dream. Don't misplace your anger. Okay, don't misplace your anger. What you should be focused on was, holy shit. That means everything they put out is controlled. You don't get that much money without doing things. There's strings attached, no matter what. Now, some will be

like, Well, I only sell gold, but the gold people also have an image. Because you have to think, who owns a gold company. They want you to say that. They want you to promote this. You should promote this, or else they won't give you enough money. Yeah, sorry, we can't fulfill that contract this

month. But maybe if you advertise this too, or this guy's podcast, maybe we'll do it. That's how they work. So, you know, these people are smart. They're just using the system and they're making money, and, you know, that's all they have for production. I mean, it's pretty lame, but don't

misplace it. You all knew who was sponsoring your media during covid, didn't you? It was Pfizer, because the ad said, brought to you by Pfizer. The thing is, the people on Twitter, the people on YouTube, grumble, Twitch, Tiktok, they don't have to tell you who sponsors them. Unless you're on Tiktok and

you're selling a product with a link or your Amazon store, no one's telling you who's funding them. They're all pretending they're just like, there, they're all funded. And you can see it from the products they sell. And once you see the products they sell, you could see what companies own those

products or people.

I've always said this follow the money. Follow the money. It never lies. Follow the money. So no one can say you're born for it. Fuck now I get, you know, people that subscribe to me and people that weaponize that too. So to the 14 people today, I only got two yesterday, so that was weird. So we got back over

the 10 for doing chargebacks on stripe. Thank you. It'll ping back on your ass. Now moving along, don't misplace your frustration. Don't misplace your frustration on human beings. Focus that frustration on the people that made that happen. Focus your frustration on the mayor. Focus your frustration on

Governor dewine. Focus your frustration on jobs Ohio. Focus your frustration to the people that made it happen, right? That's where you need to focus your frustration, not on the people, because once you realize who made that happen, then you realize how to not have it happen again. I know a lot of

people are angry when I'm telling you we're not going to deport them all. It's literally not going to happen. It is not feasible, because then you'll have elusiveness. What we want is transparency. These people came through the border willingly or unwillingly. Okay, done. It happened. They're here.

It's over. Why are you looking at the past that shit got fucked so every single one of you that voted for that idiot in the Senate, this is, oh yeah, I tried, but you know, and it's like, fuck you. You didn't try hard enough. You're out. Or the congressman, you. You know, it's like the Democrats, and it's

like, Fuck you, dude, you're working with them, kind of like I did to that new freshman Congressman who had his back up against the wall. And I was like, don't dilly dally on shit. You better start talking about this, because this is going to be a problem. And, and, and I have listeners in Arizona, they

know, a million people in one city, and you know, 400,000 of them are actually working, and they're trying to establish themselves because they found themselves here. Some of them are victims of trafficking that are too old now to get passed around, so they're just dumped on the side of the street. Maybe

we should deport them too. They didn't get fucked enough. We should just get rid of them. There are very good people that just happen to be here. There are people that have been abused and then abandoned and survived. You can get them to go to work, but the one thing we have to do is make sure that they abide by

our law. And what we have to do, I say, if you vote, you will be automatically deported. I don't care how good you are, and if you don't vote, they will vote for you. So make sure you have your shit in writing that you did not vote, because they will vote for you, which will automatically deport you. So I

So yeah, they they they can. So imagine if we swapped the tables around on them and told the illegals don't

vote because you're going to get automatically deported. But here's the thing, you may not vote, but others will vote for you, and if they vote for you, since everything is digital and on these electronic system, they can't and they'll just put your name like you voted. You're screwed. And then it's like, oh

my god. And it's gonna be like, Look, the laws deportation, that's what we're gonna do, don't don't vote. Don't vote. Write a letter and have that signed and sent in the mail with a receipt that you sent the letter and you said, No, I am not voting. It's game over. We just got the illegals on our

Well, we need to know who these people are, so we need to make sure that you know, we know who they are, let's get that real ID going, because they know Trump is going to win. So

their backup plan was that. And do you guys remember when I told you your DNA is going to be your ID? You see, when people are scared, right? this before I go. In closing, I ran into an undocumented, illegal migrant, right? And that person came from Eritrea, and so the person asked me for a lighter to smoke a cigarette. And we just started talking, and I was like, Where are you from? Oh, I'm from Eritrea. I was like, Oh, are you. Here on

business. Are you here on vacation? No, no, no. I came here. He explained to me how a Catholic charity had come by his town, his village, listen carefully to what I'm telling you, that gave them options that they would sponsor them to either go to Europe or the United States of America. Now,

if they wanted to go to the United States of America, they would have to go to a central or Southern American country where their counterparts of NGOs would pick them up and then bring them to the United States. And so the guy said, Well, you know, I had a job. He said that he's like, I had a job, you know, but

I wasn't making a lot of money. We had a couple goats on our farm. So, you know, we ate meat maybe once every three months, right? So it was a good conversation. And I said to him, you're here in this country, undocumented. You're illegally in this country. You entered illegally. He goes, Well, you

know, it is illegal, but the they they paid for us to come. And I was like, Well, don't they ask you for money? He's like, yes, but it's the money they give us from Eritrea that we hand over to the people in in America, in the Americas. He said, where, when we get to the country that's going to be

bringing us up here, we give them the money that they gave us from, you know, our home village. And I said, Well, how many people from your village have they taken? He said, Well, not everybody went. It was like, about 15. I was like, Why did you go? He goes, Well, because I was an orphan, and I had no

family. And, you know, in my community, when you're an orphan, you know, people look at you different. I'll never get married those words. But those were his reasons. Okay, so the guy came with cash, by the way, from Eritrea to a country of the Americas, where they then handed they then met the person at the

airport that was meeting all the people coming from the other countries. By the way, he said he had to wait in the airport with all the other people that that person was meeting with them, and then they took him to a building where they had, like bunk beds where they could sit, and they had lockers to put

their things away, and then they had a hand over the cash, and they took their identification and said, From now on, you are undocumented. So he has no documentation. Listen carefully. The guy has no documentation of his passport the way he flew to the Americas and he had no records of anything. And he's

like, so when they brought me to America, I was just doing whatever they told me, and that's what they told me to do. So I'm telling you what his story was. Over cigarette and I said, Aren't you terrified you're going to get deported? He goes, Well, they know that they can't deport me because they

paid for it so and it's documented. They told me that. So most of these people that are here already know that legally we can't kick them out because of the way they did it. I'm telling you. I'm explaining this to you. So anyway, I then told him, holy shit. You know, this is worth the narrator, he goes,

Well, in Eritrea, you can kill someone, and you might or might not go to jail. If it's an argument, here you go to jail. Which is better, it's safer. And I said, Well, you know, what do you think of the president? He goes, President Trump, I love him. And I was like, but he's not the president. He goes, Yes,

he is, ah. And that's where the conversation ended. Another one that I ran into was in Nashville, and it was a homeless guy. He was an addict. I'll tell you what the addicts that were selling. He stopped and asked me for cash. I didn't have any, but I had some money on my cash app, um, that, you know, people give

me, I'll use that for coffee and food and stuff like that. So I was like, I'll buy you food. So he was with his girlfriend, who was weird that had like, you know, like, a bunch of tape on. And she was just, like, it was just a weird couple, tall, thin, white guy, big black female. They just, it was just weird.

But they were addicts, heroin addicts, and so I took him to the subway that was right by the hotel, and I said, get whatever you want. And they got drinks and sandwiches for now and later. And we were talking, and they couldn't wait for President Trump to get back into office, like we weren't talking

politics. I just asked about, you know, her band aids. She said she went and gave blood, but she lost her Octa farm card. And I was like, girl, you shouldn't be doing that, but they needed money for food, and this is why I didn't give them money either. I mean, I could have went to the ATM, but I do

know that addicts will go buy things, so all I have to do is buy them some food and make sure that they're nourished and buy them Gatorade so they're hydrated. That's what we should be doing. And that was a pretty interesting conversation. Conversation too, because guess what? The one guy, the really

skinny guy, that was with the lady, he said to me that he's, he doesn't get on a phone, but when he has access to the internet, he knows he's like, this is a really like, he was a he was awake. And I was like, Damn, you're so awake. Get so drowned by, you know, the chase of heroin. But these people also

want to vote for Trump, and these are Americans that are drug addicts and out on the street. So it was pretty, you know,

interesting to see and also find out that the blood banks, and the plasma banks don't care if they're heroin users, and they'll just lie. So just saying, for all of you out there getting blood donations, blood products or plasma products, the majority of them are junkies that you know shoot up, so not

best source of getting things. So just thought I'd bring that up, um, and please be kind. It doesn't take much to be kind, you know, I didn't have to. I was late for a meeting as always, because I couldn't get an Uber. It's like, the address that I was going to was completely blacklisted in

Nashville. Like, I had to order, like, I think, like, four Ubers, and then when the other Uber came, I was like, Hey, buddy, if you drive fast, I'll pay you what I had to pay an Uber in cash too. How's that? And he went, he added three times to the fucking ride.

But

be kind, you

know, be kind.
